ORDER

WHEREAS on 3 November 2009 Staff of the Commission made a motion pursuant to sections 184(1) and 184(5) of the *Securities Act*, SNB 2004, c. S-5.5 (*Act*) seeking an *ex parte* temporary order against the Respondents;

AND WHEREAS Staff presented evidence and made submissions regarding violations of the *Act* by the Respondents;

AND WHEREAS on 3 November 2009 the Commission ordered, pursuant to sections 184(1) and 184(5) of the *Securities Act*, for a period of fifteen (15) days from the date of the *ex parte* Temporary Order, that:

- 1. the Respondents cease trading in all securities; and
- 2. any exemptions in New Brunswick securities law do not apply to the Respondents.

AND WHEREAS the Secretary of the Commission issued a Notice of Hearing on 9 November 2009 scheduling a hearing for 18 November 2009 at 10:00 a.m.;

AND WHEREAS Staff presented evidence that service of the Notice of Hearing, *ex parte* Temporary Order, Statement of Allegations, Affidavits of Ed LeBlanc, Staff's Submissions and Disclosure was effected by e-mail transmission on 9 November 2009;

AND WHEREAS the Commission is satisfied that service upon the Respondents has been effected:

AND WHEREAS a hearing was held on 18 November 2009 at 10:00 a.m. and no one appeared on behalf of the Respondents;

AND WHEREAS Staff made submissions and relied on evidence submitted for the *ex parte* Temporary Order issued on 3 November 2009;

AND WHEREAS the Commission is of the opinion that it is in the public interest to make this Order;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. pursuant to sections 184(1)(c)(ii) and 184(1)(d) of the Securities Act,
 - (a) the Respondents permanently cease trading in all securities;
 - (b) any exemptions in New Brunswick securities law do not apply permanently to the Respondents;
