The following relief and remedies will be sought at the hearing:

- 1. An order pursuant to sections 184(1)(c), 184(1)(d) and 184(5) of the Act, that:
 - a. the respondent Alan Marsh Shuman be permanently banned from trading in any securities;
 - b. Any exemptions in New Brunswick securities law do not apply to the respondent Alan Marsh Shuman,
 - c. the respondent, Alan Marsh Shuman pay an administrative penalty for

failing to comply with New Brunswick securities law; and

2. An order pursuant to section 185(1) and 185(2) of the Act that the respondent, Alan Marsh Shuman, pay the fees and expenses for the costs of investigation and the fees and expenses relating to costs of or related to the hearing.
