ORDER

WHEREAS the Respondents entered into a Settlement Agreement dated 15 November 2010 (the "Agreement") in which they agreed to a proposed settlement of violations of New Brunswick securities law, subject to the approval of the New Brunswick Securities Commission (the "Commission");

AND UPON REVIEWING the said Settlement Agreement and the Agreed Statement of Facts therein:

AND WHEREAS the Commission is of the opinion that it is in the public interest to make this Order.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- (a) Pursuant to section 191(1)(a) of the *Securities Act*, the Agreement dated 15 November 2010 with respect to the Respondents is hereby approved;
- (b) Pursuant to section 184(1)(c)(ii) of the *Securities Act*, the Respondent Trudi Hendry shall not trade in securities, other than those beneficially owned directly by her, for a period of 5 (five) years;
- (c) Pursuant to section 184(1)(d) of the *Securities Act*, any exemptions contained in New Brunswick securities law shall not apply to the Respondent Trudi Hendry for a period of 5 years;
- (d) Pursuant to section 184(1)(i) of the *Securities Act*, the Respondent Trudi Hendry is prohibited from becoming or acting as a director or officer of any issuer for a period of 5 years;
- (e) Pursuant to section 184(1)(c)(ii) of the *Securities Act*, the Respondent Shaker Management Group Inc. shall not trade in securities, permanently; and

(f) Pursuant to section 184(1)(d) of the *Securities Act*, any exemptions contained in New Brunswick securities law shall not apply to the Respondent Shaker Management Group Inc., permanently.
