NOTICE OF DISCONTINUANCE

WHEREAS on 21 December 2010, Staff of the New Brunswick Securities Commission ("Staff" and the "Commission") filed a preliminary Motion seeking a temporary Order pursuant to s. 184(1) of the *Securities Act*, SNB 2004, c. S-5.5, as amended (the "*Securities Act*") against X4 Technologies Incorporated, Kevin Joseph Surette, Ricki Landon Porter and Lee Thomas Johnston Jr. (the "respondents");

AND WHEREAS on 28 March 2011, the Commission issued a temporary Order prohibiting the respondents from trading in securities;

AND WHEREAS Staff has completed its investigation of the respondents;

AND WHEREAS Kevin Joseph Surette has provided a written Undertaking to the Commission to not trade in securities, except in and for his own account through a securities dealer registered with the Commission;

TAKE NOTICE that Staff discontinues the proceeding against the respondents and requests that the temporary Order be vacated.
