CEASE TRADE ORDER

WHEREAS on 14 September 2007 Staff of the New Brunswick Securities Commission (Commission) made application seeking an order pursuant to s. 184(1.1)(c) of the *Securities Act*, SNB 2004, c. S-5.5, as amended (the "*Securities Act*") against the Respondents;

AND WHEREAS Staff presented evidence and made submissions regarding an Order of the Ontario Securities Commission issued 3 July 2007 (the OSC Order) placing restrictions on the Respondents, among others;

AND WHEREAS the OSC Order has been extended by further Order of the Ontario Securities Commission and remains in effect;

AND WHEREAS the Commission is satisfied that Staff have provided to the Respondents an opportunity to be heard on the Application;

AND WHEREAS the Commission is of the opinion that it is in the public interest to make this Order.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED pursuant to paragraphs 184(1.1)(c) of the *Securities Act* that:

- 1. For so long as the OSC Order (as from time to time extended) remains in effect:
- (a) All trading by Al-Tar Energy Corp., Alberta Energy Corp. and their officers, directors, employees and/or agents in securities of Al-tar Energy Corp. and Alberta Energy Corp. shall cease (including, without limitation, the solicitation of trades, or any acts constituting attempts or acts in furtherance of trading, in such securities);
- (b) The Respondents shall cease trading in all securities (including, without limitation, the solicitation of trades in securities or any acts constituting attempts or acts in furtherance of trading in securities); and

(C)	any and all exemptions in New Brunswick securities law do not apply to the
	Respondents.
