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**EX PARTE TEMPORARY ORDER**

AND WHEREAS Staff presented evidence and made submissions regarding violations of the *Securities Act*, SNB 2004, c. S-5.5 by the respondents;

AND WHEREAS the Commission is of the opinion that it is in the public interest to make this order;

AND WHEREAS the Commission is of the opinion that the length of time required to hold a hearing could be prejudicial to the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED that:

1. pursuant to sections 184(1)(c), 184(1)(d) and 184(5) of the *Securities Act*,
  - a. All trading in the securities of Limelight Entertainment Inc. and/or Limelight Capital Management Ltd. by its officers, directors, employees and/or agents shall cease;
  - b. The respondents cease trading in all securities;
  - c. Any exemptions in New Brunswick securities law do not apply to the respondents;

for a period of fifteen (15) days.

2. a hearing will be held in this matter on April 26, 2006 to determine:

- a. Whether the temporary order should be made permanent; and
- b. Whether any further or other order that staff may request and the Commission may permit, should be issued.

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**NOTICE OF MOTION SEEKING EX PARTE TEMPORARY ORDER**

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An application will be made to the New Brunswick Securities Commission ("the Commission") by Staff of the Commission ("staff"), on April 11, 2006, at 1:00 p.m. at the offices of the Commission, Suite 300, 85 Charlotte Street, Saint John, New Brunswick, for an Interim Order pursuant to section 184(5) of the *Securities Act*, S.N.B. 2004, c. S-5.5 ("the Act")

**1. The following relief and remedies are being sought by staff:**

An order pursuant to sections 184(1)(c), 184(1)(d) and 184(5) of the Act, that

- a. All trading in the securities of Limelight Capital Management Ltd. and Limelight Entertainment Inc., by Limelight Capital Management Ltd. and/or Limelight Entertainment Inc., its officers, directors, employees and/or agents shall cease;
- b. The respondents cease trading in all securities;
- c. Any exemptions in New Brunswick securities law do not apply to the respondents;

for a period of fifteen (15) days from the date of the Interim Order.

**2. The grounds for this application are:**

- a. None of the respondents are registered with the Commission to trade in securities;
- b. None of the respondents have filed and received a receipt for a preliminary or final prospectus from the Executive Director for the trading in securities of Limelight Capital Management Ltd. and/or

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Limelight Entertainment Inc.;

- c. The respondents have traded in the securities of Limelight Entertainment Inc. in New Brunswick and to New Brunswick residents, without registration and without a prospectus or appropriate exemption;

**3. Evidence being relied on:**

Staff will rely on:

- a. the affidavit of Ed LeBlanc, Commission Investigator, sworn the 28<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2006 in the matter of MAITLAND CAPITAL LTD., AL GROSSMAN, HANOCH ULFAN, STEVE LANYS, JACK TRAVIN, LEONARD WADDINGHAM, SAUL MESSINGER and KIM WADHWANI.
- b. the supplementary affidavit of Ed LeBlanc, sworn April 10, 2006 in the matter of MAITLAND CAPITAL LTD., AL GROSSMAN, HANOCH ULFAN, STEVE LANYS, JACK TRAVIN, LEONARD WADDINGHAM, SAUL MESSINGER and KIM WADHWANI.
- c. the affidavit of Ed LeBlanc, sworn April 11, 2006, and

such further and other evidence as Staff may adduce and the Commission permit, in support of this motion for a Temporary Order.
