<u>Notice and Request for Comment</u> – Publishing for comments proposed amendments to New Brunswick Securities Commission Local Rule 91-501 *Derivatives* (LR 91-501).

Introduction

On 29 March 2010, the New Brunswick Securities Commission (Commission) approved publication in order to obtain comments on proposed amendments to LR 91-501.

Summary of Proposed Amendments

LR 91-501 came into force on 28 September 2009. On the same date, the New Brunswick *Securities Act (Act)* was also amended to clarify the Commission's regulatory authority and provide a legislative framework for regulating Derivatives in New Brunswick. LR 91-501 requires registration or the use of an investment dealer/portfolio manager in order to trade in derivatives.

Subsequent to the adoption of LR 91-501, the Commission received inquiries from industry in regards to the interpretation of subsection 3(2) of the rule. This subsection provides a registration exemption for trades when each party to the trade is a qualified party acting as principal.

In order to increase clarity in LR 91-501, the Commission proposes to amend the wording in subsection 3(2). Amendments will emphasize that the registration exemption only applies in the case where both parties to a transaction are qualified parties acting as principal.

Request for Comment

The Commission welcomes your comments on the proposed amendments to LR 91-501.
