ORDER

WHEREAS:

- 1. The deadline for the exchange of documents under rule 10.3 of the *Rules of Procedure* was October 17, 2018;
- 2. The City of Fredericton requested an extension of this deadline to allow it to consider the Appellants' documents before determining the scope of its evidence;

3. All other parties consent to the requested extension. However, the Appellants also requested an extension of the deadline to October 22, 2018.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The City of Fredericton's request for an extension is granted and it shall have until October 31, 2018 to provide its additional documents under rule 10.3 of the *Rules of Procedure*;
- 2. It is unnecessary to deal with the Appellants' request for an extension given their indication that they have no additional documents to submit at this time;
- 3. A separate deadline will be set pursuant to rule 10.6 of the *Rules of Procedure* in relation to identifying expert witnesses and providing expert reports;
- 4. A separate deadline will be set pursuant to rule 10.2 of the *Rules of Procedure* for the filing of *Statements of Position*, which *Statements of Position* shall set out a list of all witnesses the party intends to call, other than expert witnesses, together with a description of the anticipated testimony of each witness; and
- 5. If, after receipt of the *Statements of Position*, a party wants to provide additional documents, a request can be presented to the Tribunal for determination pursuant to Part 9 of the *Rules of Procedure*.
